NARRATIVE
ELPD Units were dispatched to a check welfare on a subject who has made suicidal statements, and the caller hasn't heard from her in approximately 35 minutes. ELPD Units arrived and Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were trying to gain entry to knock on the apartment door, but the main entrance was locked. While outside, the officers heard a female yelling, "Please help me, please help me, apartment [REDACTED], calls the cops now, help!" Officers were able to make entry and briefly communicate with a male subject at the door until he slammed the door shut and pressed his weight against the door. Upon making contact with the male subject and to the possible assault in progress, Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had their handguns displayed. Officers could visually see the female subject in the background of the apartment who had visible injuries. Officers negotiated with the male subject for approximately 40 minutes and during negotiations, the male subject told officers he wasn't supposed to be here due to court orders. During negotiations, the subject,

who was known to a couple of officers, was hiding behind the door with his hands not visible for a period, uncooperative with directions. The subject was drinking alcohol, having slurred speech, and said he had been drinking. Following negotiations, the subject eventually complied to come out into the hallway and sit down.

When Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] attempted to handcuff the subject, he showed active resistance by pulling his arms away from officers and attempted to get back up by putting his hands and knees on the ground. The subject was controlled into a belly down position but was pulling his hands underneath his body/chest. The subject was controlled and handcuffed Ofc. [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED].

ELPD Officer [REDACTED] responded to a business downtown East Lansing for an assault report and witnessed the security footage of the physical assault by two males. Observing the subject's description from the surveillance footage, Ofc. [REDACTED] provided the subject's description to ELPD Officers via radio. While responding to another call for service, Ofc [REDACTED] and Ofc [REDACTED] located the suspects, wearing the exact clothes from the surveillance footage. Both officers gave multiple commands for the subject to take his hands out of the front hooded sweatshirt pocket, but the subject didn't follow the officer's command initially. Ofc. [REDACTED] drew his handgun and displayed it at the low-ready position, providing more commands and the subject complied and was arrested for assault. The subject was determined to be a juvenile after arrest and turned over to his parents pending seeking charges for assault.

On the above and time, ELPD Officers were dispatched to Gunson St for a Breaking and Entering in progress, but it was determined the incident address is Gunson St. Officer and Officer located the two subjects in the yard, near the back of the house as they were walking away and both displayed their handguns at both Subject 1 and Subject 2. Both officers gave loud verbal commands to get onto the ground. Subject 2 complied and Ofc. displayed a taser at Subject 2 prior to hand cuffing.

Subject 1 was not complying with the officer's commands, both Ofc. [REDACTED] and Ofc. [REDACTED] displayed Tasers at Subject 1. The subject knelt down to the ground and still refused to get down on the ground fully. Det. [REDACTED] controlled Subject 1 to the ground and Subject 1 began pushing up off of the ground displaying active resistance. Officer [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] assisted with control techniques to handcuff Subject 1.

Both subjects were transported to ELPD Jail.

On above date and time, Sgt. [REDACTED] and Sgt. [REDACTED] were on walking foot patrol downtown and completing a bar check's downtown. Both officers were at Harpers when staff indicated a fight inside and both officers turned to observe two subjects actively fighting with Harpers Staff inside the main entrance, with both subjects throwing closed fist punches at the staff. Sgt. [REDACTED] called the fight out on his radio and additional officers responded. Subject 2 complied with arrest, no force used. Subject 1 ran from Harpers into Albert Ave. Officer [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] were on-scene and observed Subject 1 avoid an ELPD Officer. Ofc. [REDACTED] brought the subject to the ground using control techniques. Subject 1 pinned his hands under his chest and Ofc. [REDACTED] displayed his taser due to the subject's resistance. Ofc. [REDACTED] assisted with controlling the subject to the ground with Ofc. [REDACTED]. Ofc. [REDACTED] controlled the subject on the ground and extracted the subject's hands from underneath his body. Subject 1 was arrested and transported to ELPD Jail.

NARRATIVE

ELPD Officers were downtown on foot patrol when they noticed a verbal argument between 3 subjects in the Ann Street Triangle. Officers observed one subject walk away from the group and place a black backpack on the ground. The subject then searched through the backpack and produced a large knife in a sheath. The subject was observed removing the large, fixed blade knife from the sheath and walking towards a large group of individuals. The subject was moving forward in an aggressive manner. Officers immediately displayed their handguns at the subject. Multiple officers gave loud verbal commands to the subject. Officers positioned themselves to create a barrier to contain the threat. The subject changed direction and walked back to his backpack. The subject placed the knife in the top of his open backpack that was now directly at his feet. The subject put his hands up partially, failing to comply with officer commands. ELPD Officer [REDACTED] transitioned to less lethal and gave commands to the subject to get on the ground. The subject continued to disobey the commands. Officer [REDACTED] deployed his taser having the desired effect the subject went to the ground. Officers controlled the subject to his stomach where he was placed into handcuffs. The subject was arrested and taken to the ELPD Jail where he was offered medical attention.

Subject 1 actively resisted arrest by attempting to run away, Officer [REDACTED] grabbed the subject to stop him from fleeing, and the subject pulled her across the pavement, causing injury to Officer [REDACTED]. Officer [REDACTED] used control techniques to keep Subject 1 from fleeing and gave loud verbal commands to get on the ground. Subject 1 continued to actively resist officers by pulling away and trying to stand back up. Officer [REDACTED] tackled Subject 1 to the ground, and the subject was belly up. Officer [REDACTED] and Officer [REDACTED] used control techniques to roll the subject over for handcuffing. Officer [REDACTED] used a wrist lock as the subject wouldn't put his other hand behind his back. The subject was transported to ELPD Jail.
